We currently have 21 dementia friends attending this program. We have partnered with Gregg County Sheriff's Office and Longview Police Department, Harrison County, Marion County, Upshur County, Panola County, and Rusk County in bringing Project Lifesaver to our area. To date, we have provided over 60 families peace of mind that their wandering loved ones can be found quickly by use of the radio ID bracelet we implement for them.
